Please keep sidewalks and hydrants clear. Unclaimed items must be removed from the curb by 5 PM. Items left at the curb can result in a By-Law violation.

Consider donating unclaimed items to charitable organizations instead of placing out for waste collection.

Please respect private property and do not walk on people's lawns or gardens.

Do not block traffic and driveways or park illegally.

Only take items that are marked 'free'.
