Open House: Affordable Housing CIP Launch

Supported by \$8 million in funding from the Government of Canada's Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF), the A ffordable Housing Community Improvement Plan (CIP) will explore targeted incentives and programs designed to encourage the development of both market-rate and affordable housing throughout the community. The CIP will identify a range of financial and non-financial tools aimed at supporting diverse housing options, including "missing middle" and gentle infill housing in established neighbourhoods. The plan will be developed in three s tages, with completion anticipated in late 2025.

As part of the project launch, the Town will host a public open house on **Monday**, **September 15th at 6 p.m. a t Nineteen on the Park (19 Civic Avenue)**. Community members are invited to attend to learn more about the CIP, ask questions, and provide input on the proposed direction. A Background and Options Report will be rele ased in advance of the event to support community review and discussion.

The Town encourages participation from residents, developers, non-profit agencies, and community groups thro ughout the CIP process. Feedback gathered will help shape a plan that reflects the needs and aspirations of the g rowing Stouffville community.
