Last year in Ontario, 208 people were killed at work or died from an occupational disease.

The National Day of Mourning is a day to remember and honour those lives lost or injured due to a workplace t ragedy, and a day to collectively renew our commitment to improve health and safety in the workplace an preve nt further injuries, illnesses and deaths.

At sunset this evening, the CN Tower and the 3D TORONTO sign in Nathan Phillips Square will be lit in yello w, traditionally a colour of hope, as a visible tribute to the Day of Mourning.
